

## ScottishPower discounted Easee One charger offer terms and conditions

These terms and conditions refer to the promotional Offer (as it is defined below) offered by ScottishPower Energy Retail Limited, whose registered office is at 320 St Vincent Street, Glasgow, G2 5AD ("ScottishPower", "we", "us", "our").

### 1. The Promotion

- 1.1. The first 250 Eligible Customers (as defined below) who purchase a Easee One Smart EV Home Charger (the "**Product**") during the Promotion Period (as defined below) will be entitled to pay the reduced price of £999.00 (nine hundred and ninety-nine pounds) for the Product (such price to include the cost of Standard Installation (as it is defined in the Product Terms and Conditions)) (the "**Offer**").
- 1.2. All purchases are subject to the **Product Terms and Conditions**, as may be amended from time to time.
- 1.3. Additional costs may apply to a non-standard installation, as set out in the Product Terms and Conditions.
- 1.4. Any sale made after the first 250 Eligible Customers have purchased the Product during the Promotion Period will be charged the full recommended retail price at £1,099 ("**RRP**").
- 1.5. Any sale made after the Promotion Period has ended will be charged the full RRP.
- 1.6. The Offer will begin on 12:00am (midnight) 27th November 2023 and end once either (i) 250 Easee One EV Chargers have been sold, or (ii) 29 February 2024, whichever is earliest (the "**Promotion Period**").
- 1.7. The Offer may not be used in conjunction with any other ScottishPower promotion unless otherwise indicated.

### 2. Eligibility

- 2.1. The Offer is only available to new or existing customers who:
  - 2.1.1. are purchasing the Product either via:
    - 2.1.1.1. the ScottishPower website <https://www.scottishpower.co.uk/electric-vehicles/home-ev-chargers> ;
    - 2.1.1.2. referral links from selected partner websites; or
    - 2.1.1.3. ScottishPower's inbound telesales line at 0800 027 0004 (open from Monday to Friday 9am - 5pm).
  - 2.1.2. are UK residents; and
  - 2.1.3. are having the EV Charger installed in a domestic dwelling,

Each an "**Eligible Customer**".

- 2.2. For the avoidance of doubt, the Offer is not open to businesses and the Product may not be installed at a business premise.
- 2.3. We reserve the right to verify the eligibility of all Eligible Customers and have the right to reject any sales that appear to be duplicates, materially incorrect or fraudulent.

### 3. Liability

- 3.1. We shall not be liable any loss or damage suffered arising from the Offer (including without limitation any loss of profits, loss of revenue, loss of goodwill that arises out of or in connection with the Offer) or from our refusal to allow any individual to take part in the Offer or our withdrawal of the Offer or any other failure or inability by you to participate in or benefit from Offer for any reason.

For the avoidance of doubt, we are not involved in the administration and/or process of obtaining any grant funding.
- 5.3. By entering this promotion, the Eligible Customer accepts these terms and conditions. ScottishPower reserves the right to refuse sales of the Product to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions.
- 5.4. These terms and conditions (and all non-contractual claims and disputes) are governed by the laws of Scotland, and the courts of Scotland shall have exclusive jurisdiction of any such claims or disputes which arise out of or in connection with this offer.
